The Commissioner of Securities for the State of Montana (Commissioner), pursuant to the authority of the Securities Act of Montana, §§ 30-10-101, *et seq.*, Montana Code Annotated (2005), hereby issues the following order and notice of right to a public hearing for Respondents **JAMES A. ANDREWS, JR.** and **INVESTX, INC.** This Order is based upon the good cause shown in the allegations of fact and conclusions of law set forth in the Notice of Proposed Agency Disciplinary Action in this case.

ORDER

Pursuant to § 30-10-305(1)(a), MCA, it appears to the Commissioner that the above named Respondents **JAMES A. ANDREWS, JR.** and **INVESTX, INC** have engaged or are about to engage in an act or practice constituting a violation of the Securities Act of Montana,

and pursuant to § 30-10-102, MCA, it is in the public interest to ORDER **JAMES A.**

ANDREWS, JR. and **INVESTX, INC** to CEASE AND DESIST from the following actions:

1. Any actions or activity wherein **JAMES A. ANDREWS, JR.** and **INVESTX, INC** act as an unregistered investment adviser representative, securities salesperson, and/or broker-dealer in violation of § 30-10-201, MCA;
2. Any actions or activity wherein **JAMES A. ANDREWS, JR.** and **INVESTX, INC** offer or sell unregistered securities in violation of § 30-10-202, MCA;
3. Any act, practice, or course of business that operates or would operate as a fraud or deceit upon any person in violation of § 30-10-301, MCA; and
4. Any act that is an untrue statement of material fact or the omission of such a material fact in violation of § 30-10-301, MCA.

Section 30-10-306(1), MCA, provides that any willful violation of this cease and desist order, upon conviction, may be punished by imprisonment for not more than ten years and/or a fine not exceeding five thousand dollars (\$5,000).


NOTICE

Respondents are notified that the Commissioner has issued this temporary cease and desist order. If Respondents wish to contest the allegations herein, they shall make a written request for a hearing to Roberta Cross Guns of this office within 15 days of receipt of this order. The hearing shall then be held within 30 days of the Commissioner's receipt of the hearing request unless otherwise agreed by the parties. If no hearing is requested within 15 days of receipt of this order by Respondents, and the Commissioner orders none, this order shall become permanent.

Should you request a hearing, you have the right to be accompanied, represented and advised by counsel. If the counsel you choose has not been admitted to the practice of law in the

State of Montana, he or she must comply with the requirements of *Application of American Smelting and Refining, Co.*, 164 Mont. 139, 520 P.2d 103 (1973).
