



shall not be considered in any manner as prejudicing my case and is not in any sense an admission of guilt, and I hereby wholly exonerate and hold blameless in this matter the authorities of Cascade County, Montana, and all persons connected with such authorities of Cascade County, Montana, and agree to accompany to the State of Montana any Peace Officer who may be sent to take me to said state.
