



EXHIBIT A

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual undertakings established herein, the Department and Mollring, as the parties to this agreement, enter into the following:

AGREEMENT

A. Without admitting or denying any of the findings of fact and conclusions of law set forth in the Notice of Proposed Agency Disciplinary Action and Opportunity for Hearing (attached hereto as Exhibit A), Mollring hereby stipulates and consents to the following:

1. Mollring will comply with the Montana Insurance Code, and the rules and orders promulgated thereunder.

2. Mollring will pay a fine of \$1000.00 to the State of Montana. Mollring may pay the amount owed in two equal monthly payments of \$333.00 and a final payment in the third month of \$340.00, from the date this agreement is signed.

3. Mollring waives his right to a hearing on the allegations contained herein; and

5. The statute of limitation is tolled for one year from the date of consummation of this agreement with regard to the allegations set forth in the Department's Action. In the event Mollring violates the terms of this agreement or violates the insurance laws of any other state during the one year period, Mollring shall pay a fine to the Commissioner of Securities and Insurance of the Office of the State Auditor's Office in the amount of \$5,000.

B. Pursuant to Mollring's stipulation, the parties agree and stipulate as follows:

1. This agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties, there being no other promises or agreements, either express or implied. Pursuant to statutory authority, the Department hereby agrees that the Department will not initiate any civil, administrative, or criminal action against Mollring regarding the allegations contained in the Department's Action.

2. Mollring fully and forever releases and discharges the Department, the Commissioner of Securities and Insurance of the Office of the State Auditor (CSI), and all CSI employees from any and all actions, claims, causes of action, demands, or expenses for damages or injuries that may arise from the allegations underlying this agreement, whether asserted or unasserted, known or unknown, foreseen or unforeseen, arising out of the Action.


