On December 21, 2012, the Office of the Commissioner of Securities and Insurance (CSI) issued a Temporary Order to Cease and Desist and Opportunity for Hearing (C&D) and a Notice of Proposed Agency Disciplinary Action and Opportunity for Hearing (Notice). The C&D and the Notice alleged that the Respondent violated Mont. Code Ann. § 33-18-208(2), (4), by offering free dinners valued in excess of five dollars as an inducement to insurance after being admonished by the CSI from so doing.

The CSI's current interpretation that Mont. Code Ann. § 33-18-208 proscribes the offering of anything of value in excess of five dollars as an inducement to insurance is a long-standing interpretation dating back to the late 1990's. This value was an adjustment to the late 1980's valuation, which was set at two dollars.

The CSI has agreed to reconsider its interpretation of Mont. Code Ann. § 33-18-208 in light of the passage of time and in consideration of other states' interpretations of

similar statutes. Therefore, this matter is hereby dismissed pursuant to Rule 41(a)(1)(A),
Mont.R.Civ.P.
