**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE:**

On December 5, 2017, the Office of the Montana State Auditor, Commissioner of Securities and Insurance (CSI), received a complete proposed merger application, including a plan and agreement for its merger, proposing the merger of TDJ Insurance Corp., a St. Christopher and Nevis captive insurance company (TDJ STCN), with and into TDJ Insurance Corp., a Montana captive insurance company (TDJ MT). TDJ MT will be the surviving company from the merger. The boards of each company have approved this transaction. Both companies have common management and boards of directors. The

purpose of this merger is to redomesticate TDJ Insurance from St. Christopher and Nevis to Montana.

Pursuant to the authority set forth in Mont. Code Ann. § 33-28-111 of the Montana Insurance Code, the CSI is providing notice to the public prior to approval or disapproval of the merger in place of holding a hearing.


The Commissioner will approve the proposed merger on **December 15, 2017**, unless the CSI determines evidence received, if any, indicates that the plan or agreement:

- a) is inequitable to the policyholders of any domestic insurer involved in the merger; or
- b) would substantially reduce the security of and service to be rendered to policyholders of the domestic insurer in Montana or elsewhere. § 33-3-217(2).
