**ORDER GRANTING
CONTINUANCE OF
SHOW CAUSE HEARING
AND EXTENDING
TEMPORARY RESTRAINING
ORDER**

On April 15, 2016, based on the petition of the Commissioner of Securities and Insurance, Montana State Auditor (Petitioner), the Court issued a Temporary Restraining Order in this case, and set a show cause hearing for April 21, 2016, at 1:30 p.m.

Respondent Catherine Ann Finberg (Finberg or Respondent) moved for a continuance of the show cause hearing, claiming the need for additional time for

her to secure legal representation and to allow counsel to prepare a response to the temporary restraining order. The Petitioner does not object so long as the temporary restraining order remains in effect.


The Court finds good cause pursuant to Mont. Code Ann. § 27-19-317 for an extension of the Court-imposed deadline of April 25, 2016, contained in the temporary restraining order. This finding is based on the representation of Respondent's counsel during a telephonic Court hearing held April 21, 2016, at 9:00 a.m. Respondent was not served with the temporary restraining order dated April 15, 2015, until April 20, 2016, due to her absence from the country. Thus, there is a need for additional time for her to secure legal representation and to allow her counsel to prepare a response to the temporary restraining order.

Based on the foregoing, the Court orders the following:

1. The hearing currently set for April 21, 2016, at 1:30 p.m. is VACATED;
and
2. The Show Cause hearing is reset for Wednesday, May 11, 2016, at 1:15 p.m. at the Flathead County Justice Center, 920 South Main Street, Kalispell, Montana.
3. The injunctive relief stated in the Court's temporary restraining order of April 15, 2016, remains in effect. The temporary restraining order shall

expire on May 11, 2016, unless extended by the Court pursuant to § 27-19-317 or terminated earlier by order of the Court.
