WHAT IS THE MONTANA SECURITIES ACT?

The Montana Securities Act, in part, allows entrepreneurs to raise money from Montana investors. CSI regulates state requirements on how Montana investments are structured, including filing and reporting requirements, and investor qualifications.



WHAT IS A SECURITY?

- Raising money from investors, this is—by definition—a security.
- If you have Montana investors, with limited or no business control, that ownership is likely a security.
